



## Ontario lab results on myUHN

You can view your lab test results and pathology reports from other labs and hospitals in Ontario on [myUHN](#). These results are stored in the **Ontario Laboratories Information System (OLIS)**. Accessing these results, as well as your UHN results, gives you a more complete record of your care.

### Important Information About Your Results and Reports

- You can see your results as soon as they are ready in your electronic health record. Your results may change or be updated after you see them.
- You may see your results before you see your doctor at your next appointment. If you have questions, your health care team will explain your results.
- Your health care team will contact you if they need to see you sooner than your next appointment.

### How can I view my lab results?

1. Sign into your myUHN at [www.myuhn.ca](http://www.myuhn.ca) or use the MyChart App

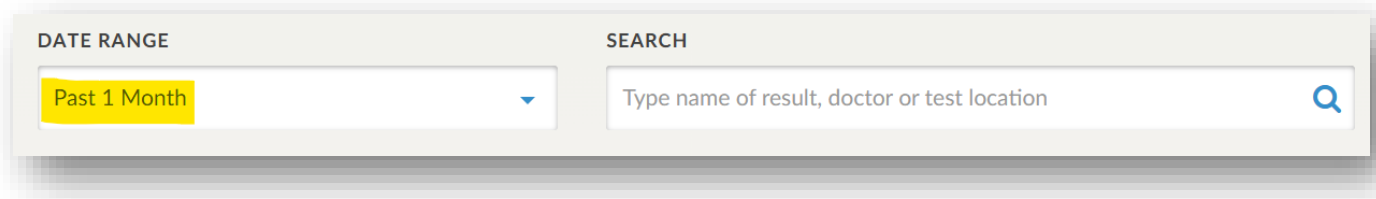


2. Click on **Ontario Lab Results (OLIS)**

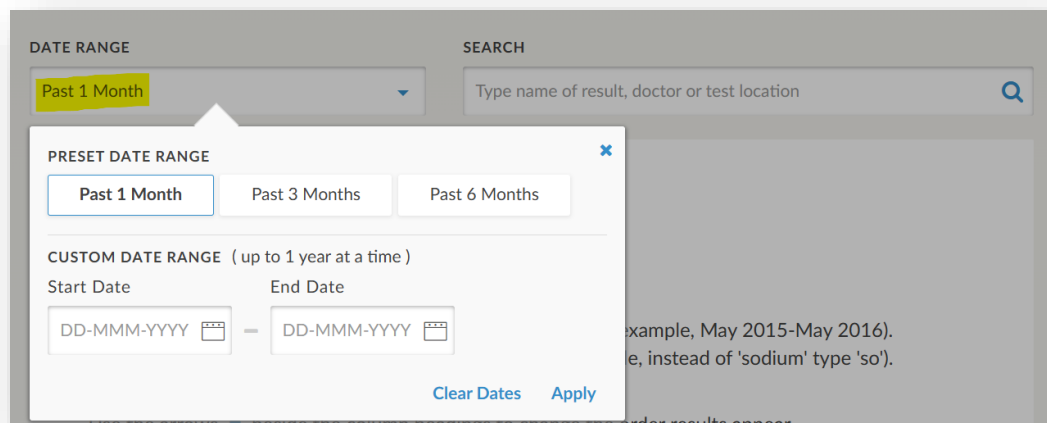


3. A new web page (tab) will open that brings you to Ontario Lab Results.
4. Your results will appear under **'Results & Reports'**.

5. You can view by **DATE RANGE** on the left, or **SEARCH** by the test name, doctor or location on the right. The date range defaults to “Past 1 Month” as highlighted in yellow below:



6. You can change the date range by clicking the '**DATE RANGE**' menu highlighted in yellow. A pop-up will appear that allows you to change the date range. To note, you must enter a date range that is within the last year.



7. Once you have selected a date range, all your results and reports within that date range will show under '**Results and Reports**'. You can also use the **SEARCH** option on the right to find the report or result you are looking for.



8. To view the result, click on the blue button 'More details' on the right side.
9. Ontario Lab Results are being viewed on a separate page (tab). Make sure you sign out when you are done.
